The clues:

1. Inside the notice board on the wall of the old council offices, what is the third big beige word on the poster (it has an arrow)?
2. Take the footbridge across to the carpark, what is the word in graffiti on the boarded up house (it's on it a few times)?
3. Head along the High Street. In the window of Indian Villa, what does the poster say you can do as much as you like?
4. In the window of Boots, what does the Healthy Living Pharmacy poster with people say: who is it for?
5. What is in the window of the big yellow house next to Cutters? A ..... dress.
6. On the poster on the door of Bird Box (the pet shop), what is the missing word: Wild Bird .....?
7. In the window of Tatty Boyd, what shape is on the bracelets with purple bands?
8. In the window of The Travel Shop, what does the poster with palm trees say in capital letters?
9. Head for Market Square. What's the name on the shop sign in Market Square, next door to the Double Take salon?
10. Head towards the URC. What is on the logo of Chapman Stickels on the old Corn Exchange building opposite the URC?
11. In the front garden of the URC, to the left of the bench, next to the holly tree, look at the memorial stone: what name can you spell out with the 1st, 3rd, and 7th letters of the first name and the 10th letter of the name underneath it?
